How Do I Apply?

Applications must include applicants name, high school and class year level, and contact details: a mobile/phone number and email address.

Applicants must explain in 300 words:

- What the intern hopes to achieve in the programme;
- How the intern hopes to contribute to the museum and the public through their participation;
- Why the programme will contribute to their future career aspirations.
