The 2019 year has been one of many positives for the Kawerau District.

The district continues to provide a great base for industry and manufacturing which is supported by the ongoing work of the Industrial Symbiosis Kawerau (ISK) group.

We want to recognise Waiū Dairy which opened this year providing some 30 jobs. Waiu Dairy is a great example of enterprise collaboration as its owned by 11 Māori businesses and Imanaka a 138-year-old Japanese family-owned business.

We also want to recognise the \$23 million investment by Asaleo Care to their Kawerau plant signaling their ongoing commitment to our district.

We continue to work with other industries looking to establish in Kawerau.

There has also been great progress with the ISK's Kawerau Pathways to Work cadetship programme. This is an employer-driven initiative by Kawerau for Kawerau rangatahi that moved into the second phase thanks to the support of the Government's Provincial Growth Fund (PGF).

Two rangatahi are already part-way through their 13-week cadetships with the Kawerau i-SITE and Sequal respectively. More cadets start in the New Year with other employers.

There have been many great events run by the Council staff including WoodFest, King of the Mountain, the re-opening of the Sir James Fletcher Kawerau Museum and Christmas in the Park. A huge thank you to all our community volunteers who supported our events. A special thank you to our Kawerau Youth Council.

The Maurie Kjar Memorial Pool Complex is looking fabulous after the recent maintenance overhaul and the Parks and Reserves team have met their usual high standard throughout the district.

Remember, the Library is a great place to entertain the family and visitors during the summer holidays.

Digital Workshops for Families



The Kawerau District Library delivered the first Digital Wellbeing Programme at Tarawera High School with 10 families recently.

The Library has partnered with the Digital Inclusion Alliance Aotearoa (DIAA) and Te Aka Toitu Trust to deliver the programme to Kawerau families.

The programme is run by Library staff and aims to provide knowledge, skills and internet connectivity to parents. It consists of two four-hour sessions after which each family gains a "Digital Licence" and takes home the device they used in class to keep and share with their whanau.

More workshops are planned in early 2020. Families can approach their school to register their interest.
